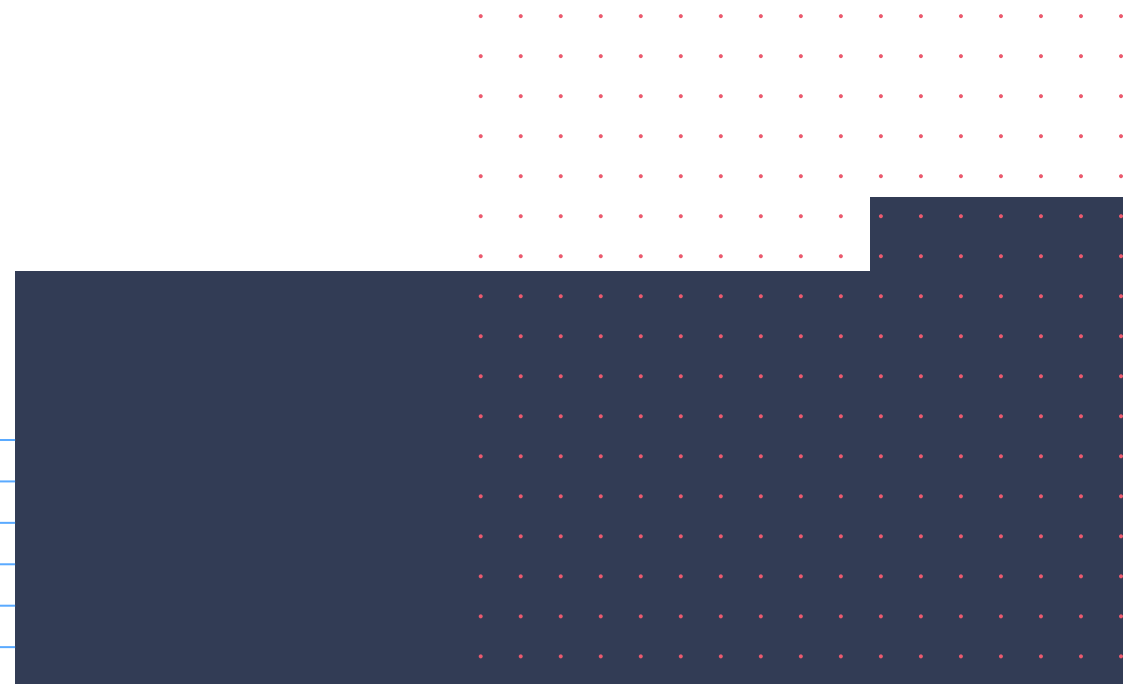

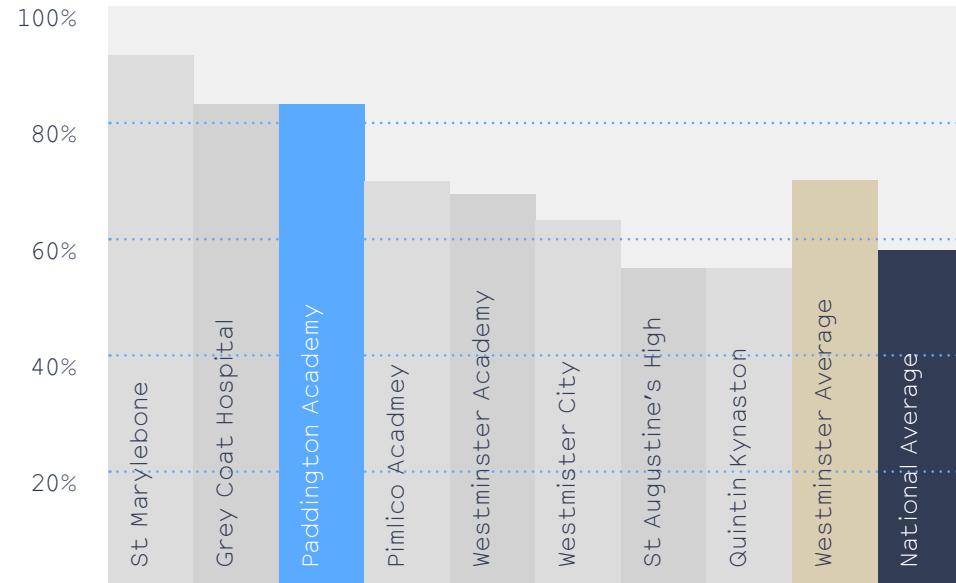
Paddington Academy

We have worked intensively with Paddington Academy for the past seven years, supplying tutors to the school during both term time and school holidays. Manning's 'in-school' programmes have provided focussed assistance to pupils on a one-to-one, or small group, basis. The emphasis was initially placed upon the C/D borderline students, although work has also been done to improve grades at the top end of the spectrum.

During our initial period of employment from 2008 to 2011, the number of students achieving 5 A*-C GCSE grades (inclusive of Maths and English) increased from 24% to 62%. The CVA increased from 977 to 1072 – making it fourth in the country!

In 2012 the results improved again, with 75% achieving 5A*-C grades (inclusive of Maths and English). With our continued support, Paddington Academy have maintained this high standard, achieving 83% in 2013.

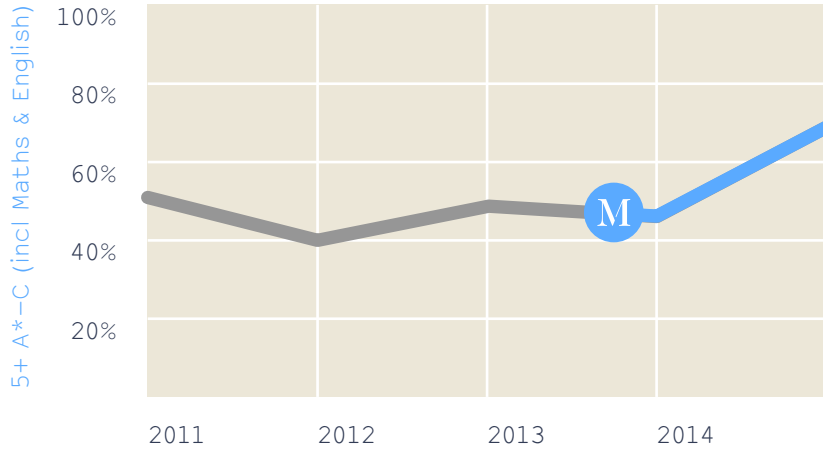

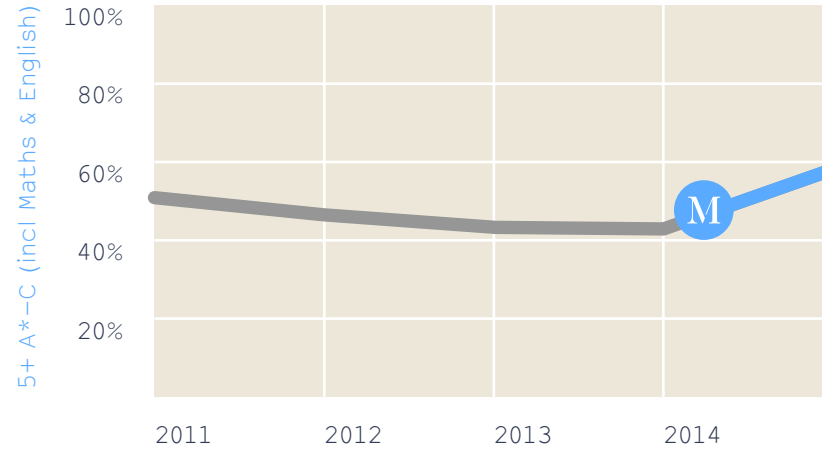

M = Manning's begins to work with the school

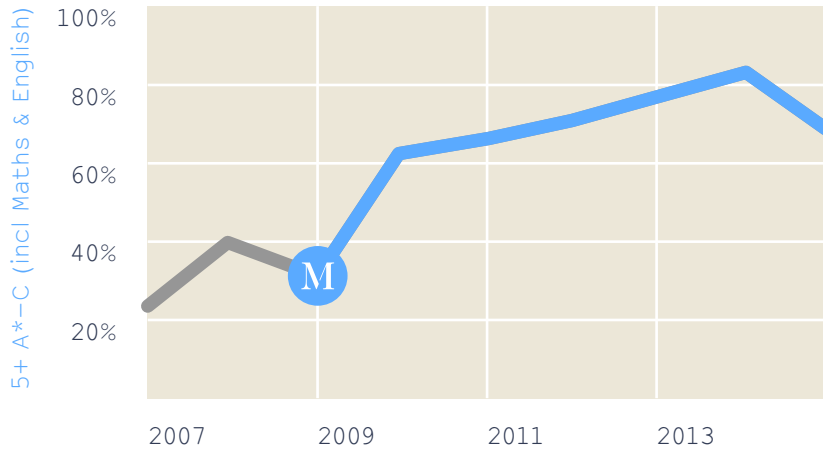

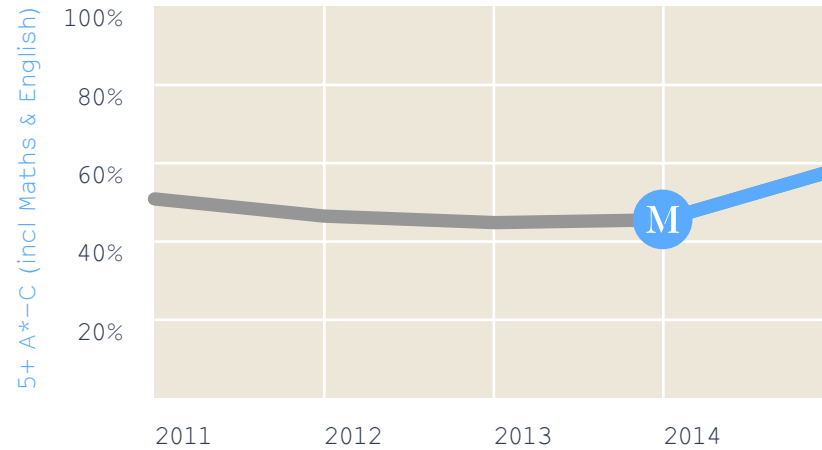

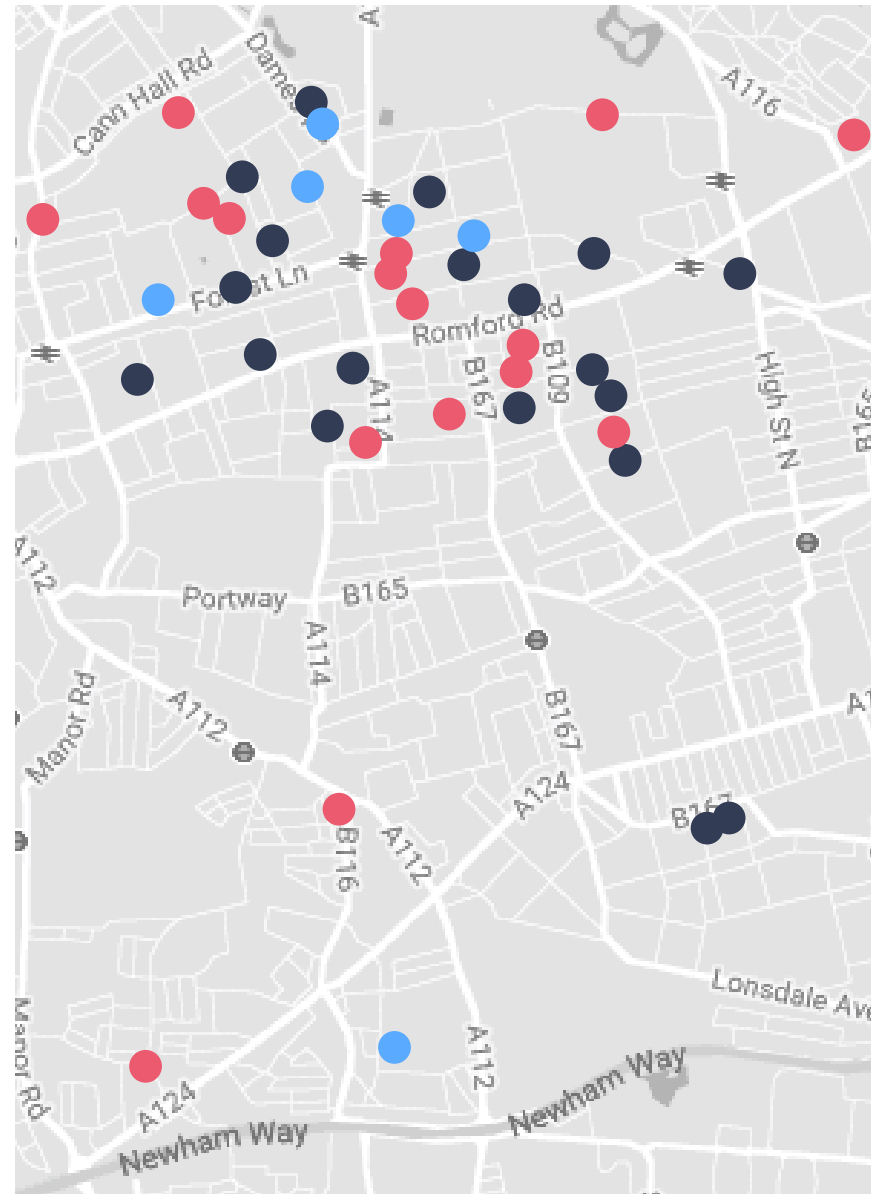
Forest Gate

In 2011 Manning's tutors were employed to support Forest Gate Community School's creative use of their Pupil Premium funding by providing Year 11 pupils with a course of 10 one-to-one private tuition sessions. Primarily targeted at the C/D borderline pupils in both Maths and English, it was instrumental in the effort to raise the all-important 5+ A*-C (including Maths & English) statistic.

After running the initial pilot scheme with 44 pupils throughout the 2011/12 school year, the number of pupils achieving the 'C' grade increased from 54% in 2010/11 to 61%.

Following its success, this scheme was renewed and subsequently adopted by Quintin Kynaston Academy.

The entire of year 11 sat a GCSE maths mock exam each fortnight. The 40 pupils with the lowest progress received 30 minutes tuition daily for the next two weeks. The year group were then tested again, and the process repeated.

Saint Gabriel's

Saint Gabriel's offered a course of 10 tuition sessions to pupils in English (November), Science (January) and Maths (March).

A 10-week course of tuition costs less than one-third of a child's Pupil Premium allocation. The table below compares the cohort's working grades at the start of their tuition with their actual GCSE result

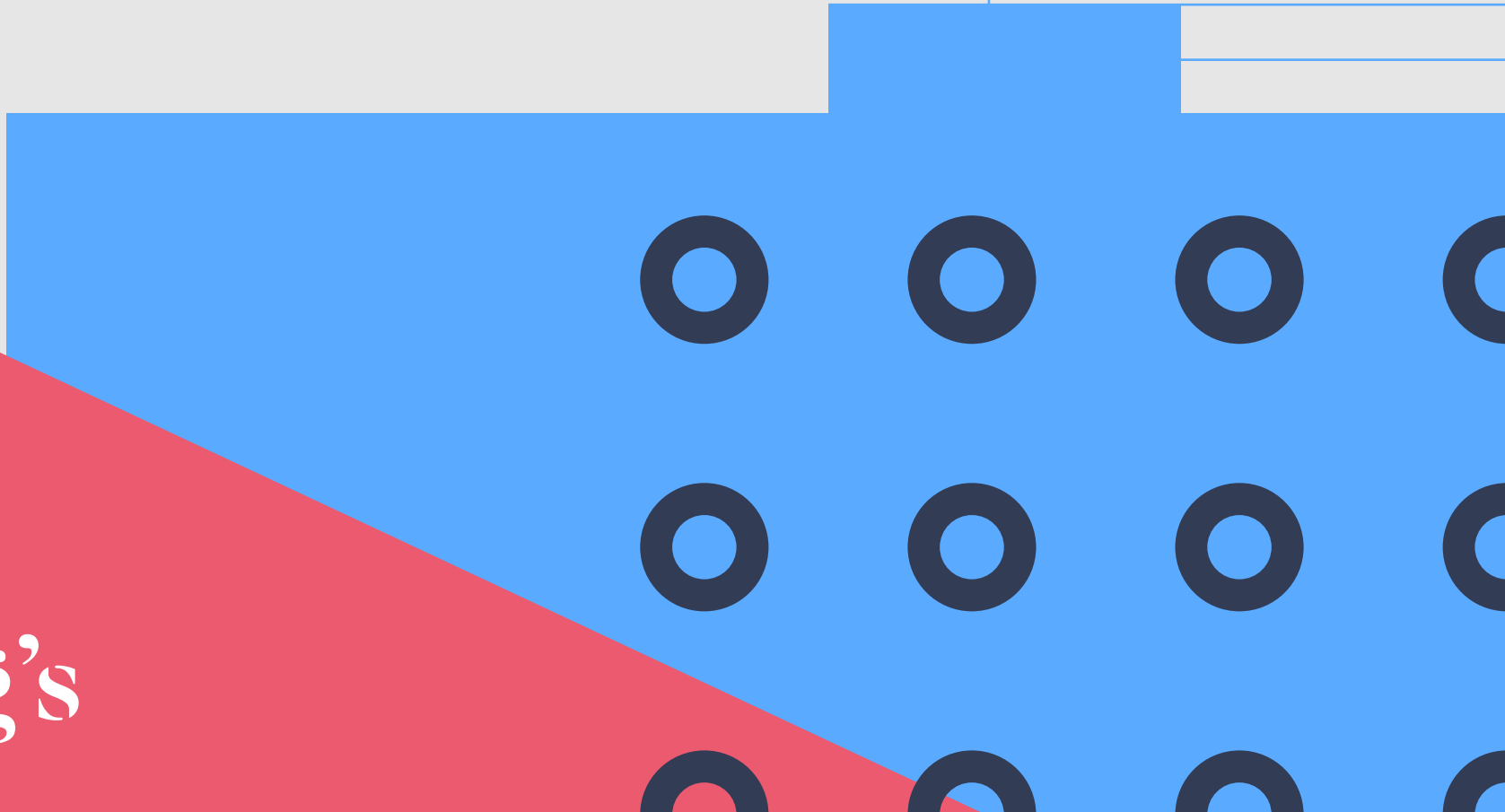
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
